Transport to competition center



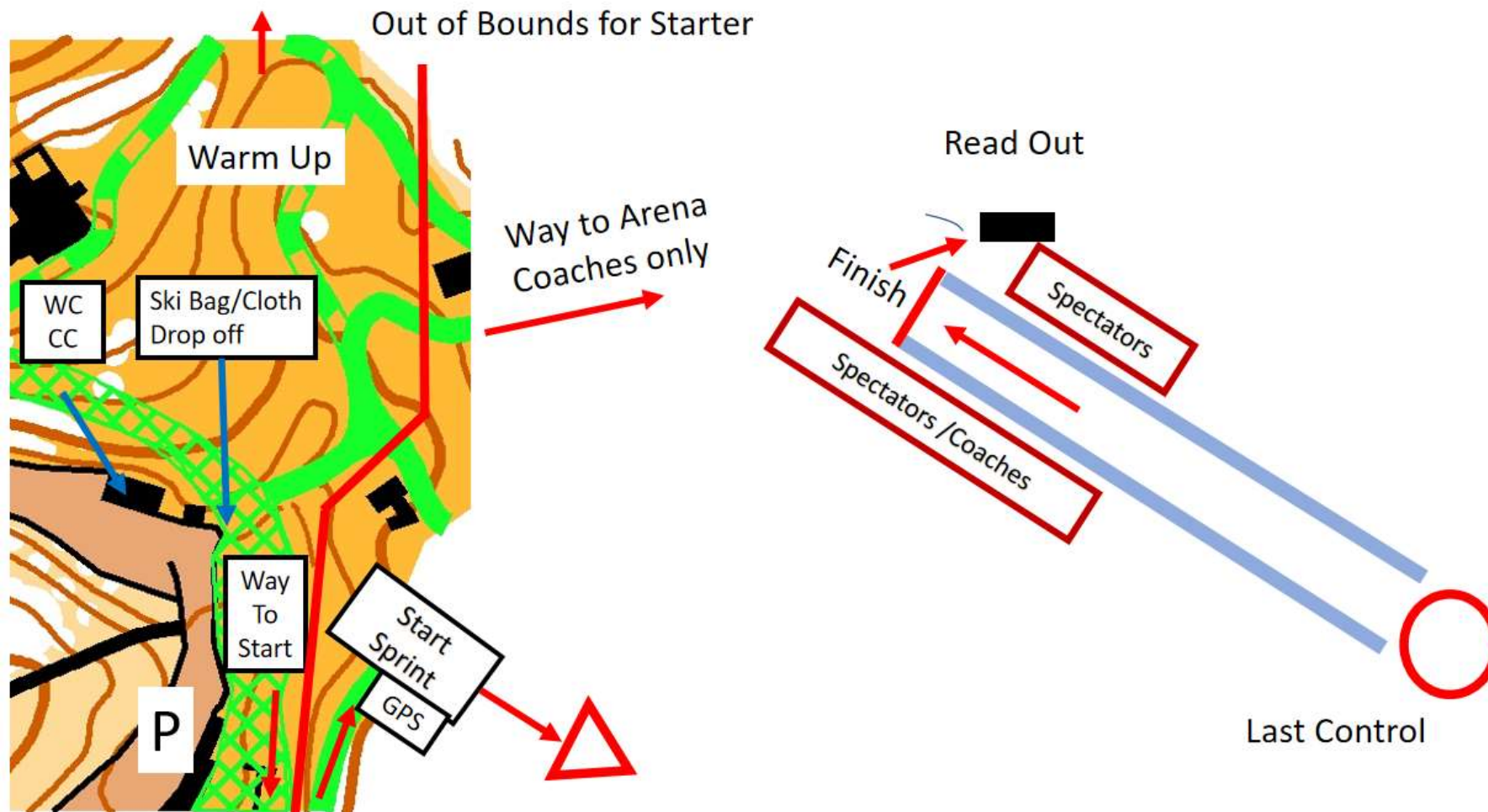
- No official Transportation

Fluor Ban



- Per ruling of the IOF Council, the use of fluorinated waxes is forbidden. Details published in Bulletin 3.
- All World Cup and Ski-O Tour Elite competitors are required to fill out, sign and hand in to the event office a declaration of conformity. A signed declaration is mandatory for participation in the event.
- Spot checks of waxing products used are possible.

- Alpin Carst Terrain with deep dolines (be aware when shortcutting)
- Quality depending on sun exposure
- Currently compact and frozen and partially uneven
- snow mobile routes
- shortcutting: not all terrain is snow-covered beside the tracks

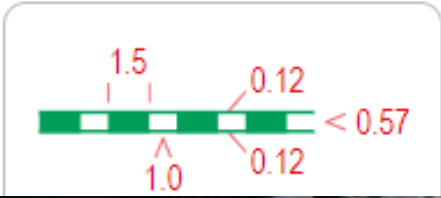

- do not carry SI units on same arm as your Watch

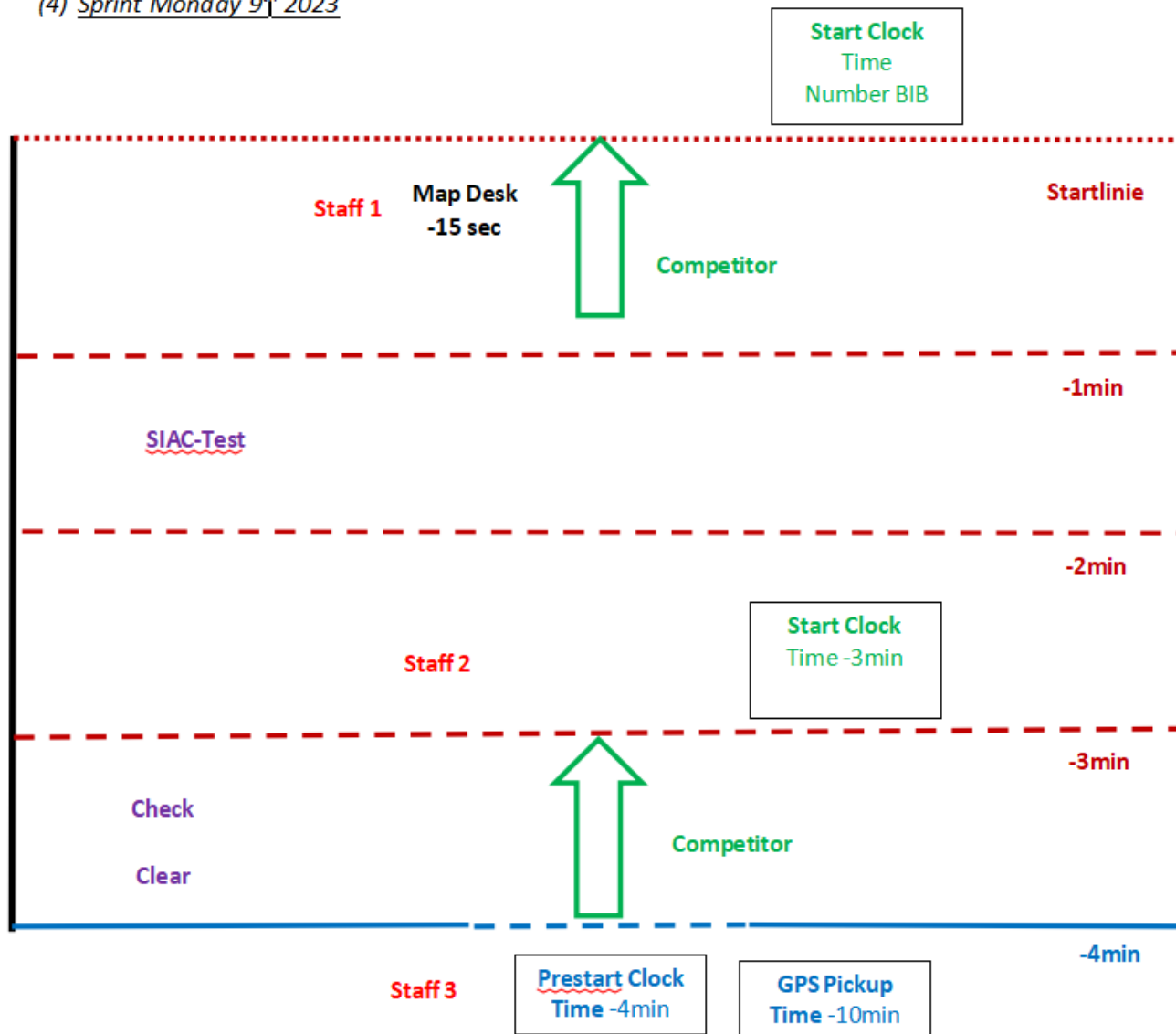
Quarantine



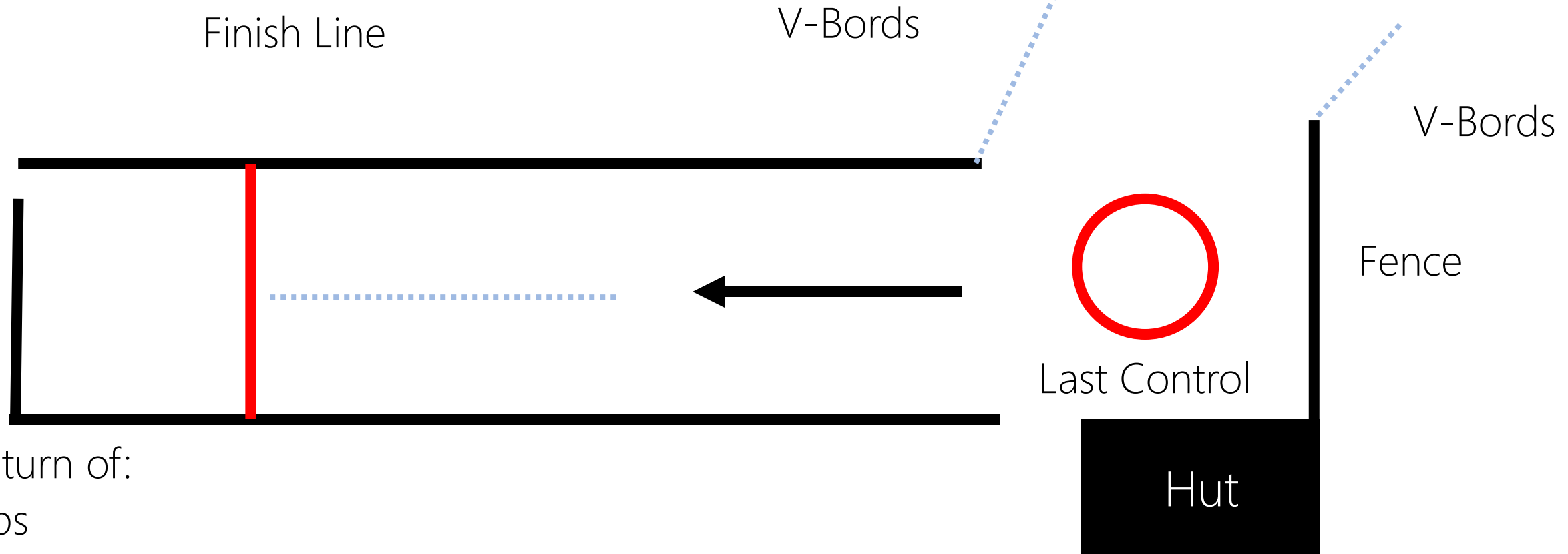
- No Quarantine possible in the area

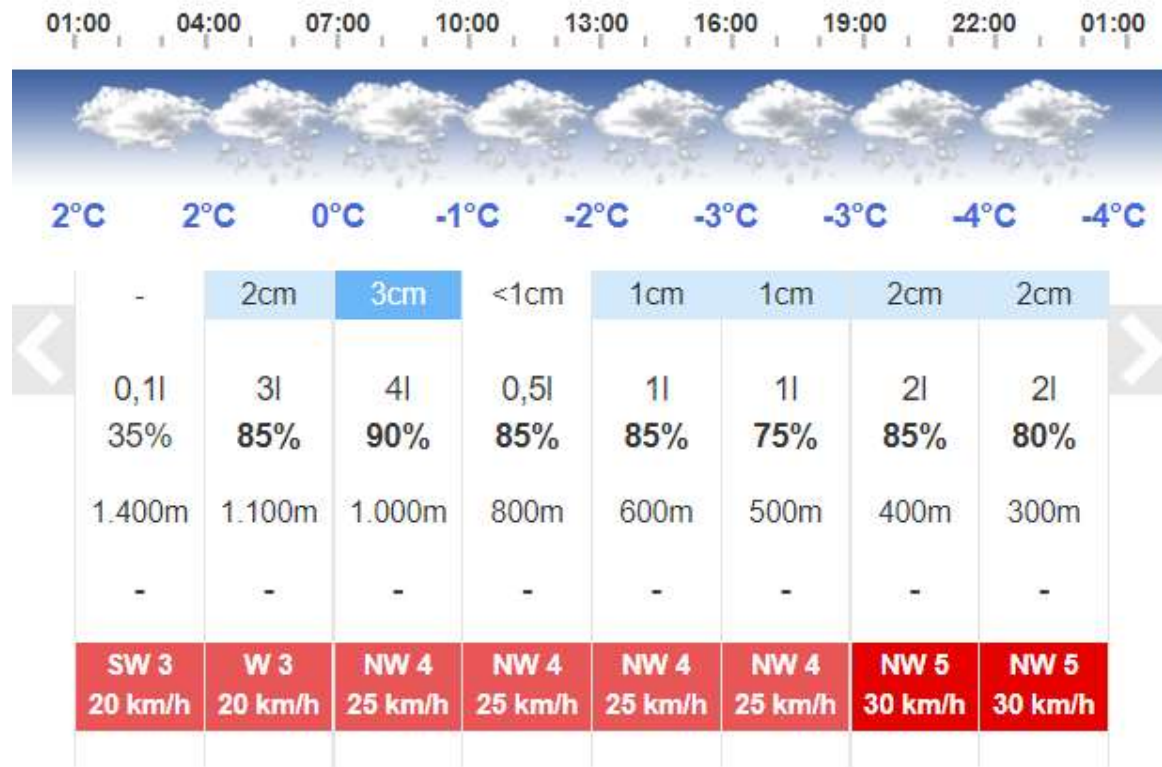

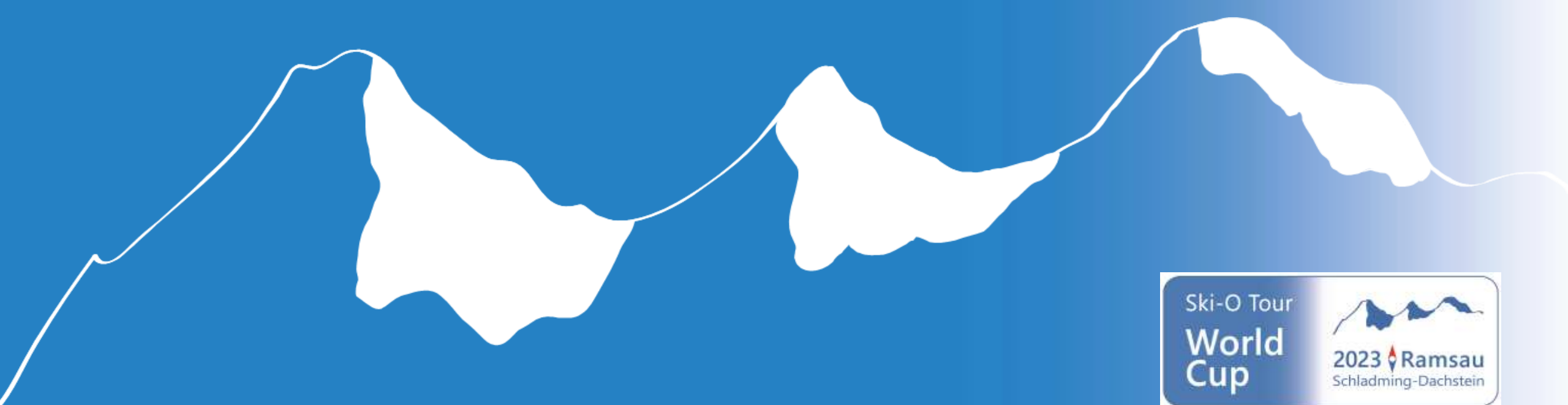
